- 1) **Under utilized fish Control:** Under utilized fish, such as carp, are degrading wetlands and spawning areas around Lake Manitoba, There is currently no market for under utilized fish. The general feeling is that there is a need to develop a market to control under utilized fish populations. Motion was passed for the Chair to write Minister Melnick regarding the harmful effects of under utilized fish species and the potential benefits of using the under utilized fish for economic benefit.
